Organization Description

As a registered charity, Community Volunteer Connections (CVC) advances volunteerism through events, hosted learning opportunities, and one-to-one volunteer support. It also aids public serving organizations, charities, societies, and grassroots organizations by providing access to volunteer recruitment resources, and volunteer management services. CVC advocates for a benevolent and inclusive society through volunteerism. Community Volunteer Connections operates within the unceded, traditional, and ancestral territory of the Kwikwetlem First Nations, which dwells within the shared territories of the Tsleil-Waututh, Sto:lo, Qayqayt, Katzie, Musqueam, and Squamish nations in the region known today as the Tri-Cities.

Board Responsibilities

Board Directors:

- Establish and monitor the vision, mission, strategic direction and core values of the society.
- Approve and uphold financial responsibilities, and the annual budget of the society.
- Monitor financial control systems to maintain the financial and legal responsibilities of the society.
- Govern and maintain Board Committees, setting terms of reference with clear responsibilities.
- Evaluate the performance of the Executive Director in accomplishing society goals within developed Board policies.

Board Director Requirements and Qualifications:

The time commitment for a Board Director's role includes preparation for and appearance at monthly board meetings, strategic planning sessions, the Annual General Meeting, and participation on at least one Board Committee. Board members are also expected to attend select CVC events.

Board Directors:

- Show an interest in advocating for civic engagement at the local level, especially through volunteerism.
- Demonstrate an ability to apply strategic thinking skills and set strategic priorities.
- Display a commitment to inclusion, diversity, equity, and accessibility.
- Understand a local viewpoint, either as a resident or worker in the Tri-Cities.

Skills and expertise in the areas of finance, law, human resources, risk management, or fund development is an asset. Board experience is preferred.
